a three-spot for the first period and led 3-0.
Agawam scored its only goal of the game in the second period, when Passerini connected with assists from Frigo and Dylan Slich. The Brownies threatened a couple more times, but could not come up with anything else while Longmeadow put up another pair and took the commanding 5-1 lead.
Agawam's defense played much better in the third period, finally

shutting down Longmeadow's deep offense, but the Brownie offense could not do anything with that momentum and Agawam dropped to 2-9 for the regular season.
Longmeadow had five different players score goals.
Agawam goalie Nick Brady continued his very busy season with 30 saves on 35 shots in the game. Agawam's offense was limited to just 20 shots on goal.
The loss followed Agawam's second win of the season, which came on Jan. 20 against Amherst on the road. Amherst plays in Division 3A.
The Brownies have defeated one team in Division 3 all season, East Longmeadow in the first game of the

season.
Agawam is 1-5 against Berry Division opponents and also has no victories against Central or Eastern Massachusetts teams. Agawam is currently in fifth place out of six teams in the Berry, with just Minnechaug behind them. The Falcons are winless in the division and have just two wins all season, after making the playoffs the last two seasons. Agawam has not made a playoff appearance in four years.
The Brownies have a big matchup coming up on Feb. 1 against struggling Minnechaug, then face Auburn at Olympia Ice Center in West Springfield. Agawam's next four games will be played at the Olympia.
