## Canadian singer/songwriter celebrating Thoreau

WILLIAMSBURG – Jeffrey Riordan Hinich, a Canadian singer, songwriter and author, will visit twice this July. First to perform at the Angel Park Music Series, en route to the Thoreau Society’s annual gathering, and then on his return trip for a collaborative program with the Meekins Library and the Williamsburg Woodland Trails Committee.

Hinich, author of *Waking With Thoreau*, *Lungs of the Planet* and *Other Possibilities* will perform at the July, 13 Angel Park Music Series at 6 p.m., in honor and celebration of the 200th birthday of Henry David Thoreau.

The Library and Williamsburg Woodland Trails Committee program will begin at 2 p.m. on Sunday, July 16 for a group reading of Thoreau’s *Walking* essays followed by a saunter on a Williamsburg woodland trail.

The Thoreau Society’s Annual Gathering in Concord transpires every July around Henry’s birthday, July 12. Hundreds gather for the four day symposium where all things Thoreau as well as Transcendental takes place with an array of speakers, nature walks around Concord and Walden Pond, as well as musical and theatrical presentations.

A graduate of Botany from the University of Wisconsin, Milwaukee, Hinich has spent years defending a role for old growth forests, actively advocates for the Coalition for Algoma Passenger Trains. He lives with his wife, singer-songwriter, Britta Wolfert in the Algoma highlands of Northern Ontario where he manufactures hand split, white cedar shakes.
