Whites first-year coach, is very glad that Kapinos is his starting goalkeeper this summer.

"Joey is a great goalkeeper and I'm very happy that he's playing for my team," Rodrigues said. "He also plays for a professional indoor soccer team and he's been a big part of our success."

The Whites (8-2-3), who entered the league playoffs as the fifth-seed, were scheduled to face fourth-seeded Legacy Fire (9-3-1) in a quarterfinal match at Lusitano Stadium on Monday night. The regular season matchup between the two teams ended in a tie.

"We've been missing a lot of guys during the past couple of weeks," Rodrigues said. "We should be at full strength when the playoffs start and I'm very excited to see what we can do."

Griffin's Café (6-3-4), who captured the PVSSL men's championship title for the first time a year ago, began this year's playoffs as the seventh seed. They were scheduled to face second-seeded Lusitano Red (10-1-2) in the second quarterfinal match played at Lusitano Stadium on Monday night.

"We feel like that we're one of the top eight teams in this

league again this year," said Griffin's Café forward Troy Remillard. "We need to play well in the playoffs in order to defend our title. We just fell behind early in tonight's game and we could never recover."

Remillard scored a goal in last year's championship game against top-seeded Villa Napoletana of East Longmeadow, which was decided in penalty kicks. He'll be a senior captain of the Western New England University men's soccer team in the fall. His younger brother, Matt, will be a freshman member of the team. Troy's older brother, Jon, is the boys varsity soccer coach at Palmer High School. Matt and Jon are also key members of the Griffin's Café squad. There are also three Mercer's (A.J., Eddie, Jamey), who are from South Hadley, and four Prickett's (Jaime, Sam, Jordan, Luke) listed on the Griffin's Café roster.

Not to be outdone the Lusitano Whites roster is also filled with brothers or cousins.

Jaime Kapinos is Joey's brother. There are also four Goncalves (Adam, David, Manny, Mike) listed on the roster, along with Curtis and Gabriel Pereira.

During the 14th minute of the opening half, David Goncalves

fired a shot into the right corner past Griffin's Café keeper Mark Tiffany, who's from Belcher-town. Curtis Pereira was credited with the assist, which was Goncalves third goal of the regular season.

Twenty minutes later, the Whites made several passes before Sukru Yildirim blasted a shot into the right corner. Kyle Tomas, who was also a member of the Western Pioneers this summer, was credited with the assist on the Whites second goal.

At the start of the second half, the Whites had a golden opportunity to take a 3-0 lead, but they missed a wide open shot attempt.

In the middle of the second half, it appeared like Griffin's Café would slice the deficit in half on a shot by Brett Longobucco, but Joey Kapinos kept his shutout bid intact by making an outstanding diving save.

"I normally make a lot of those point blank saves during the indoor season," Kapinos said. "Luckily, I was able to make the save on that shot."

The two teams could possible face each other again in the men's championship match, which is scheduled to be held at Lusitano Stadium on Friday night.
