- Liquidation Channel, currently available on Spectrum Select, will move to Spectrum Basic

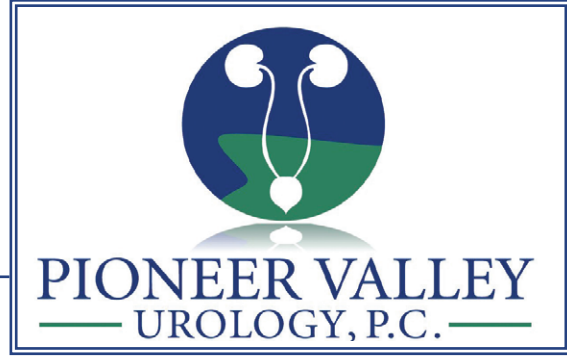
