CDC expands updated COVID-19 vaccines to include children ages 5 through 11

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has approved the expanded use of the updated (bivalent) COVID-19 vaccines to children ages five through 11 years. This follows the Food and Drug Administration's authorization of updated COVID-19 vaccines from Pfizer-BioNTech for children ages 5 through 11 years, and from Moderna for children and adolescents ages six

through 17 years.
