Sealed Bids for the construction of the "Everett Avenue Pipe Lining Project" will be received by the Department of Public Works/Select Board at the Town Hall, Select Boards Office, Belchertown, MA 01007 until 2:00 p.m. local time on October 12, 2023 at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. Sealed Bids must have outer envelope marked as "Town of Belchertown, Everett Avenue Pipe Lining Project".

The work consists of 1,150 linear feet of sanitary sewer cured-in-place pipe lining, and manhole rehabilitation for 9 manholes along Everett Ave. Bids shall be on a unit price basis.

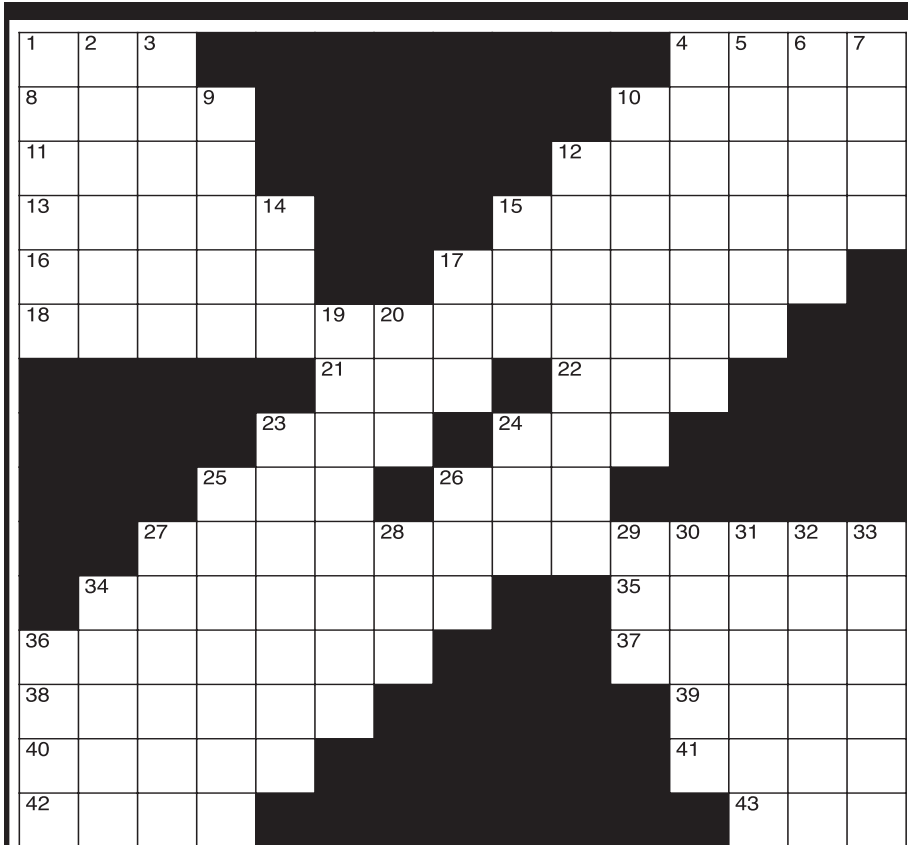
