DONATIONS from Page 1 it dropped drastically. For those unsure about donating, if you are spring cleaning and find clothes that don’t fit anymore or don’t wear, we will gladly accept them. If you have the means to go to the grocery store, every bit counts. We always take monetary donations as well,” said Turcotte.

On the CSC website, communitysurvivalcenter.org, an Amazon wish list can be found as well as a donation tab with links to directly donate to the center. Turcotte explained that the center’s goal in 2026 is to better serve the communities by adding more visits. Currently the center can assist families six times a year, beginning in July and ending in June.

The families can use them however they want, if they space their visits seven days apart. “They could use four in a month but then

only have two lefts. A few families used up all their visits in the summertime, and I don’t know what they’re doing for the rest of the year. If we could offer eight visits instead of six, then maybe they could stretch it out a bit longer. We also have a senior program. Anyone over the age of 60 in Hampden County can come in once a month; they get 12 visits per year. We also have a preschool program for any children who are not in school, who are home all day; they get 20 servings of breakfast and lunch once a month. We would like to also help so that parents can make it through the month,” ended Turcotte.

Turcotte wanted to note and urge residents to avoid illegal dumping around the Planet Aide box in the parking area; it costs the center a lot of money to get rid of the items. For more information, visit the CSC website.
