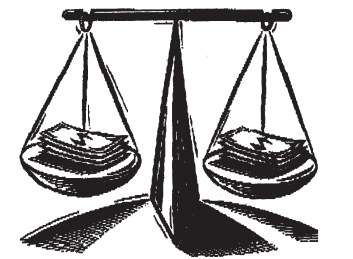

North Brookfield receives risk management grant

NORTH BROOKFIELD – The Town of North Brookfield was awarded a \$9,200 risk management grant from the Massachusetts Interlocal Insurance Association, the town's property and casualty insurance provider, to support a lockout/tagout station, a winch tripod with harness for confined space work and a Safety Care trainer.
 The town said the grant has enhanced the safety, preparedness, and effectiveness of its municipal workforce. The town said the lockout/tagout station has improved safe equipment servicing at the wastewater treatment plant, the confined space equipment has strengthened sewer department safety during high-risk operations, and the Safety Care trainer has helped equip school

staff with skills to prevent injuries and respond appropriately to challenging situations.
 "We are extremely grateful to MIIA for providing this funding and helping us make meaningful investments in employee safety across multiple departments," said Jamie Gilman, chair of the Board of Selectmen. "I would also like to recognize and thank our Administrative Assistant to the Board of Selectmen, Mary Beth Kularski, for her efforts in identifying and securing these grant opportunities that directly benefit our employees and residents. These funds will help keep our school staff, Sewer Department personnel, and other municipal employees safer while they perform the essential work that serves

our community every day."
