

Rotary Club presents TREK Sturbridge Halloween 5K, 1K & Fun Walk

STURBRIDGE – Runners, walkers, families and Halloween enthusiasts are invited to hit the trails again this fall when the Rotary Club of Sturbridge presents its annual TREK Sturbridge Halloween 5K, 1K and Fun Walk on Sunday, Oct. 25.

Pre-registration is now open for the family-friendly event, according to Race Director Klaus Hachfeld. Participants can pre-register at RaceRoster.com by entering “Sturbridge” in the search field.

Those who register before Oct. 19, will receive this year’s free collectible TREK Sturbridge Halloween 5K T-shirt.

“Partnering with TREK Sturbridge has become a great way to bring people together, enjoy some of Sturbridge’s beautiful trails and have a little Halloween fun at the same time,” Hachfeld said in a press release. “More importantly,

every registration helps Rotary put money back into the community through scholarships for local students and support for other community projects and needs.”

All activities begin at the Old Sturbridge Village Education Center on Old Sturbridge Village Road. Par-

ticipants should note that the Education Center is not the Old Sturbridge Village Academy located near the village’s main entrance.

Parking will be available in the Education Center lot.

The event features a timed 5K Trail Run, a Fun Walk and a timed 1K Pre-

Teen Run. In keeping with the Halloween spirit, participants are encouraged to come in costume. Activities begin at 9 a.m. with a free costume parade, relay races and organized games for young children at the Education Center.

The timed 1K Pre-Teen Run begins at 9:15 a.m. and is

open to children ages 12 and younger. Registration is \$20, and the course is accessible to participants with mobility challenges.

The timed 5K Trail Run and Fun Walk begin at 10 a.m. The course follows Old Sturbridge Village Road and the Arbutus Park Trail through the Leadmine Mountain Wildlife Conservation Lands.

Registration is \$35 for the 5K and \$30 for the Fun Walk.

Registered runners and walkers can also compete in the Best Costume competition prior to the 11:15 a.m. awards ceremony, with winners selected by popular choice.

Race-day registration will be available beginning at 8:30 a.m. Participants may register on their own devices using a QR code available at the site.

Paper registration forms will also be available for those unable to register online.

The TREK Sturbridge Halloween 5K, 1K & Fun Walk is a fundraiser of the Rotary Club of Sturbridge, with proceeds supporting the club’s scholarships for local students and other community service projects.

“People who participate in the TREK Sturbridge Halloween 5K, 1K & Fun Walk aren’t just signing up for a race,” Hachfeld added. “They’re helping Rotary continue the work we do throughout the year to support students, families and organizations in our community. We hope they’ll come out, bring the family, wear a costume and make a morning of it.”
