The subject matter of the pro-posed amendments is as indicat-ed below. The complete text rela-tive to the proposed amendments is available for inspection in the Planning Department Office and Town Clerk’s Office during regu-lar business hours. Proposed zoning bylaw revisions are in draft form and are subject to change.
Proposed zoning bylaw revi-sions to include the following:
1. Organizational amendments: Replacing the entire existing zoning bylaw with a rewritten version intended to improve or-ganization, readability and syn-tax and without changing content or meaning
2. Accessory Dwelling Units: Adding language to the pro-visions governing Accessory Dwelling Units and related park-ing requirements, as previously directed by the Massachusetts Attorney General’s Office, so as to bring the bylaw into full com-pliance with the requirements of current state law and regulations
3. Data Centers: Amendment and/or additions to the existing zoning bylaw to regulate the lo-cation, siting, or to establish the possible prohibition of Data Cen-ters within the Town of Ludlow.

Irma Medina has been named dean new HCC division of Integrative and Applied Learning

HOLYOKE – Irma Medina of Springfield, an alum and 22-year employee of Holyoke Community College, has been named the inaugural dean of the HCC division of Integrative and Applied Learning.
“For more than two decades, Irma has served HCC with dedication and distinction, championing student success, equity, belonging, and experiential learning,”

said Jessica Nicklin, HCC provost and vice president of academic and student affairs. “This is an important leadership role, and I’m delighted to make this announcement.”
Medina, the daughter of a seamstress, was a single mom and working full time as a secretary when she enrolled in night classes at HCC in 1997, taking a bus to college every day from her home in Springfield’s North

End. She is a graduate of Springfield’s High School of Commerce, where her best class was typing, she said, and her ambition at the time merely to get a better paying secretarial job.
“That was all I knew,” she said.
Later, Medina transferred from HCC to Mount Holyoke College on a Frances Perkins scholarship.
She graduated in 2004

with a bachelor’s degree in urban politics and a minor in history.
She soon returned to HCC as an academic advisor for the TRIO program, and two years later became the inaugural coordinator of what was then a new transfer program called Pathways, which she led as coordinator for the next 17 years.
In 2023, she was named director of Integrated Learn-

ing, overseeing a comple-ment of linked programs that includes Pathways, Honors, Learning Communities, Community Based Learning, and Academic Internships.
This summer, Integrat-ed Learning was elevated to become its own academic division under the new title of Integrated and Applied Learning, with Medina as its first dean.
“Those who know Irma

recognize her as a thoughtful leader, a trusted colleague, and a passionate advocate for students,” said Nicklin. “I am confident that her vision, collaborative spirit and unwavering dedication to HCC’s mission will continue to enrich our students’ lives and strengthen our college community.”
