Residential Lock Box Promotion

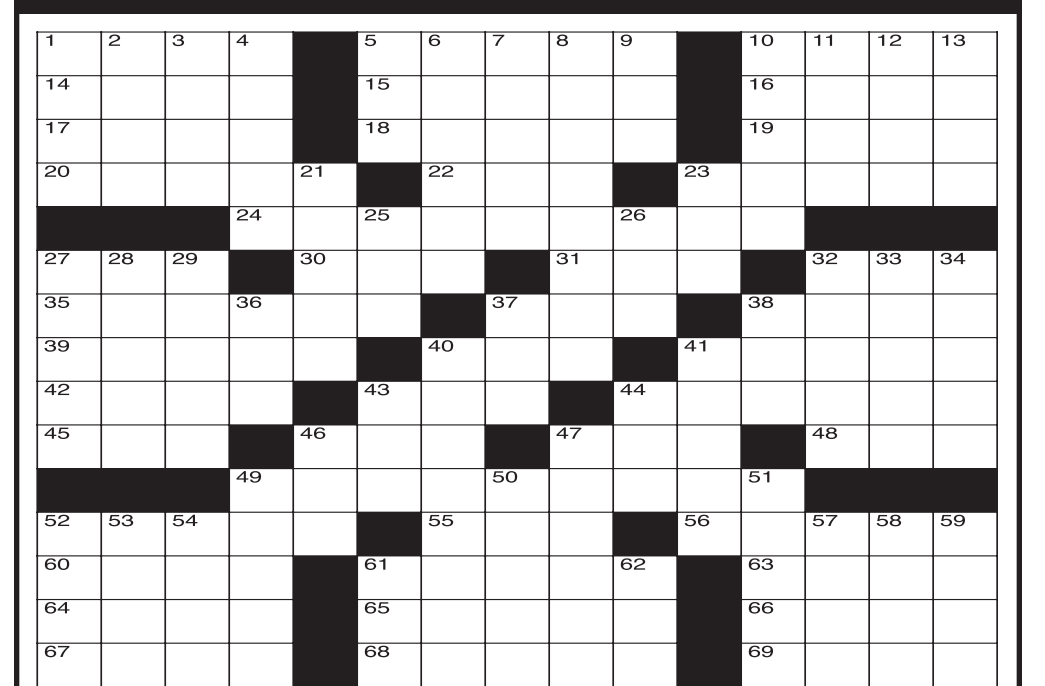
SOUTH HADLEY – To celebrate Older American's Month, the Friends of the South Hadley Seniors will be subsidizing the cost of a lock box installation for any applications received by May 31. For the month of May, a lock box can be purchased for just \$10. This program, sponsored by TRIAD, normally offers lock boxes for \$35. Lock boxes provide a secure, exterior storage for house keys, which allows emergency responders access without having to breakdown the doors. Applications are avail-

able from the Council on Aging and can be returned to the COA with the \$10 payment (checks payable to TRIAD). Applications must be received by May 31st to receive the discount.
