

MLT Volunteer Trail Maintenance Hikes this Fall

HAMPDEN - Mark your calendars! The Minnechaug Land Trust trail maintenance team is happy to announce TWO opportunities for maintenance hikes in Hampden this Fall 2026.

We will have a Minnechaug Mountain Fall Maintenance Hike on Saturday Sept. 26 9:30 to 11:30 a.m. and a Goat Rock Fall Maintenance Hike on Saturday Oct. 10, 9:30 to 11:30 a.m.

Our first fall maintenance hike takes place on Saturday Sept. 26 from 9:30 to 11:30 a.m. at Minnechaug Mountain. Those who have hiked Minnechaug know that after traversing the moderately steep terrain on the way up, you are rewarded with amazing views of the Pioneer Valley at the summit. With all of our warm summer weather, the shrubs and brush along

the parking lot and at the top of the mountain have started to take over. We are looking for volunteers to clear brush both at the summit overlook and at the parking lot around existing bog bridges and rock wall at the entrance.

Volunteers should plan to meet at the South Rd parking entrance on Sept. 26 at 9:30 am. The parking entrance is located roughly 0.5 miles from Main Street, Hampden, on the right-hand side of South Rd. We will split into groups and hike up the mountain from there. Hikers who are familiar with the trails are welcome to park at any of the entrances to Minnechaug and meet us at the top of the mountain during the maintenance hike. Our second fall maintenance hike takes place on Saturday Oct. 10th, from 9:30 to 11:30 a.m. at Goat Rock Conservation Area. Many hikers in Hampden and the surrounding towns know and love Goat Rock and its trails. Due to the popularity of Goat Rock and its trail system, we will need volunteers to help with various tasks, including trash pickup, clearing weeds and brush from the three overlook vistas along the trails, and maintaining trail edges and boundaries.

Please meet us at the trailhead in the Memorial Park parking lot on Oct. 10 at 9:30 a.m. Memorial Park is located at 495 Main Street, Hampden. Volunteers are welcome to meet up with us on the trails anytime between 9:30 to 11:30 a.m. A digital

Come enjoy stellar views of the Valley while working together to preserve and enhance two of our favorite places to explore. Thank you for your support. Theatre Guild of Hampden presents ‘Gypsy: The Musical’

HAMPDEN – The Theatre Guild of Hampden will be presenting their fall production of “Gypsy: The Musical.”

Gypsy tells the story of the dreams and efforts of one hungry, powerhouse of a woman to get her two daughters into show business. Gypsy is loosely based on the 1957 memoir of famous striptease artist Gypsy Rose Lee, entitled “Gypsy: Memoirs of America’s Most Celebrated Stripper.”

The memoir and the musical focus on the story of Gypsy Rose Lee’s mother, Rose, and earned Rose a place in the theatrical and literary canon as the quintessential, archetypal “Stage Mother.”

The musical features songs that have become standards of the musical theatre canon, including “Some People,” “Let Me Entertain You,” “Rose’s Turn,” and

the show-stopping “Everything’s Coming Up Roses”.

Gypsy is famous for helping launch lyricist Stephen Sondheim’s career, and features a book by Arthur Laurents that is widely considered to be one of the classic examples of a traditional “book musical.” At the heart of the musical is the gregarious Rose, whose journey made critic Frank Rich call Gypsy, “Broadway’s own brassy, unlikely answer to King Lear.”

The shows dates are Oct. 16, 17, 18, 23, 24 and 25.

The shows will be at the Hampden Town Hall, (Formerly Thornton Burgess School), 85 Wilbraham Road Hampden, MA.

The showtimes are Friday and Saturday at 7:30 p.m. and Sunday Matinees at 2 p.m.
